The event

The Embassy of Japan in Pakistan will announce a significant contribution from the Government of Japan to UN agencies in Pakistan to support programmes benefitting internally displaced persons (IDPs) and Afghan refugees.

The contribution will support the work of the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UN-OCHA), the World Food Programme (WFP), the UN Development Programme (UNDP), the UN Refugee Agency (UNHCR), and UN-Habitat to support those who have been displaced persons from North Waziristan Agency by recent military action in the region.

A joint event has been organised by the Embassy of Japan and the UN in Pakistan to formalise the announcement.
